Lye Brae Footbridge, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2009

On 12 March 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on footbridge refurbishment works) on the footbridge over B8054 Lye Brae, Cumbernauld from its junction with Clouden Road to its junction with Glenhove Road (South) by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north-east side of the closure (Clouden Road) wishing to access the south-west side of the closure (Glenhove Road – South), should proceed north-westwards on the un-named footpath to Tarbolton Road, south-westwards across the footbridge over B8054 Lye Brae to Glenhove Road (North) then proceed south-eastwards to Glenhove Road (South) and the south-west side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south-west side of the closure (Glenhove Road-South) wishing to access the north-east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 23 March 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 20 July 2009.

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Lye Brae Footbridge, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2009” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty third day of March, two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Friday, the twentieth day of July, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of persons engaged on footbridge refurbishment works) on the footbridge over B8054 Lye Brae, Cumbernauld from its junction with Clouden Road to its junction with Glenhove Road (South) by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north-east side of the closure (Clouden Road) wishing to access the south-west side of the closure (Glenhove Road – South), should proceed north-westwards on the un-named footpath to Tarbolton Road, south-westwards across the footbridge over B8054 Lye Brae to Glenhove Road (North) then proceed south-eastwards to Glenhove Road (South) and the south-west side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south-west side of the closure (Glenhove Road-South) wishing to access the north-east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
