

North Lanarkshire Council
Burnbrae Road, Auchinloch
(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

On 18 March 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the construction of Kirkintilloch Link Road) on Burnbrae Road, Auchinloch from its junction with B757 Stepps Road, eastwards, south-eastwards and eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of Blacklands Farm Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling northwards on B757 Stepps Road at the western side of the closure, wishing to access the east side of the closure, should continue north-westwards on B757 Auchinloch Road, north-eastwards and south-eastwards on B819 Lindsaybeg Road and south-westwards on Burnbrae Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles travelling southwards on Auchinloch Road at the western side of the closure, wishing to access the east side of the closure should continue south-eastwards on B757 Stepps Road to M80 Roundabout, exit Roundabout and proceed north-westwards on B757 Stepps Road and Auchinloch Road, north-eastwards and south-eastwards on B819 Lindsaybeg Road and south-westwards on Burnbrae Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling southwards on B819 Lindsaybeg Road at the eastern side of Burnbrae Road wishing to access the west side of the closure should continue south-eastwards on B819 Lindsaybeg Road, south-westwards on A752 Cumbernauld Road and A80 Cumbernauld Road, northwards and north-eastwards on Lenzie Road and northwards on B757 Stepps Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling northwards on B819 Lindsaybeg Road at the eastern side of Burnbrae Road wishing to access the west side of the closure should continue north-westwards and south-westwards on B819 Lindsaybeg Road and south-eastwards on B757 Auchinloch Road to the west side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.

Vehicular access will be permitted, where practical, during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 30 March 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Tuesday, 30 March 2010.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Burnbrae Road, Auchinloch) (Temporary Closure) Order 2009" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the thirtieth day of March, two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Tuesday, the thirtieth day of March, Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the construction of Kirkintilloch Link Road) on Burnbrae Road, Auchinloch from its junction with B757 Stepps Road, eastwards, south-eastwards and eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of Blacklands Farm Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling northwards on B757 Stepps Road at the western side of the closure, wishing to access the east side of the closure, should continue north-westwards on B757 Auchinloch Road, north-eastwards and south-eastwards on B819 Lindsaybeg Road and south-westwards on Burnbrae Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles travelling southwards on Auchinloch Road at the western side of the closure, wishing to access the east side of the closure should continue south-eastwards on B757 Stepps Road to M80 Roundabout, exit Roundabout and proceed north-westwards on B757 Stepps Road and Auchinloch Road, north-eastwards and south-eastwards on B819 Lindsaybeg Road and south-westwards on Burnbrae Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling southwards on B819 Lindsaybeg Road at the eastern side of Burnbrae Road wishing to access the west side of the closure should continue south-eastwards on B819 Lindsaybeg Road, south-westwards on A752 Cumbernauld Road and A80 Cumbernauld Road, northwards and north-eastwards on Lenzie Road and northwards on B757 Stepps Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling northwards on B819 Lindsaybeg Road at the eastern side of Burnbrae Road wishing to access the west side of the closure should continue north-westwards and south-westwards on B819 Lindsaybeg Road and south-eastwards on B757 Auchinloch Road to the west side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.

Vehicular access will be permitted, where practical, during the closure.
