Register Avenue, Bellshill
(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

On 19 March 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage works) on Register Avenue, Bellshill from the extended line of the western kerb of Hamilcomb Road, south-eastwards and north-eastwards to its junction with Liberty Road, over its entire length by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to access the south-west side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards on Liberty Road, south-westwards then north-westwards on New View Drive and north-eastwards on Hamilcomb Road to the south-west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south-west side of the closure wishing to access the north-east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the closure.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.

The Order, which will be effective only when signing is in place, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 30 March 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 10 May 2009.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Register Avenue, Bellshill) (Temporary Closure) Order 2009” and will be in operation only when signing is in place, shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the thirtieth day of March, two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Sunday, the tenth day of May, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (engaged on drainage works) on Register Avenue, Bellshill from the extended line of the western kerb of Hamilcomb Road, south-eastwards and north-eastwards to its junction with Liberty Road, over its entire length by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to access the south-west side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards on Liberty Road, south-westwards then north-westwards on New View Drive and north-eastwards on Hamilcomb Road to the south-west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south-west side of the closure wishing to access the north-east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the closure.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.
