

North Lanarkshire Council
Tay Street, Coatbridge
(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

On 25 March 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer connection works) on Tay Street, Coatbridge from a point 40 metres or thereby north of its junction with Deveron Street northwards to a point 71 metres or thereby south of the extended line of the southern kerb of Leven Road, a distance of 22 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed northwards on Tay Street, eastwards on Leven Road, southwards on Tantallon Drive, westwards on Deveron Street and northwards on Tay Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0900 hours on Sunday, 5 April 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 1 May 2009.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Tay Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Closure) Order 2009" and shall be effective during the period from 0900 hours on Monday, the fifth day of April, Two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Friday, the first day of May, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer connection works) on Tay Street, Coatbridge from a point 40 metres or thereby north of its junction with Deveron Street northwards to a point 71 metres or thereby south of the extended line of the southern kerb of Leven Road, a distance of 22 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed northwards on Tay Street, eastwards on Leven Road, southwards on Tantallon Drive, westwards on Deveron Street and northwards on Tay Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the closure.
