Various Roads, Hareshaw Village, Near Cleland

(Temporary Closures) Order 2009

On 8 April 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the upgrading of electrical cabling works) on the under-noted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Phase 1

Hareshaw Road over its entire length.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on A73 Carlisle Road on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Greenhill Road on the northwest side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on A73 Carlisle Road, north-eastwards on B7066 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road and south-eastwards on Linrigg Road and Greenhill Road to the northwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on Greenhill Road on the north east side of the closure wishing to access A73 Carlisle Road on the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Phase 2

Linrigg Road from the extended line of the south-eastern kerb of Hareshaw Road to the extended line of the south-east kerb of Wilsons Road.

Greenhill Road from the extended line of the south-eastern kerb of Hareshaw Road, south-eastwards, a distance of 100 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on Hareshaw Road wishing to access Linrigg Road on the northwest side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on Hareshaw Road, south-westwards on A73 Carlisle Road, north-eastwards on B7066 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road and south-eastwards on Linrigg Road to the northwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on Linrigg Road on the northwest side of the closure wishing to access Hareshaw Road should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Hareshaw Road wishing to access Greenhill Road on the south east side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on Hareshaw Road, south-eastwards on A73 Carlisle Road, north-eastwards on Fernieshaw Road and north-westwards on Greenhill Road to the south east side of the closure.

Vehicles on Greenhill Road on the south east side of the closure wishing to access Hareshaw Road should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Linrigg Road on the north west side of the closure wishing to access Greenhill Road on the south east side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on Linrigg Road, south-westwards on B7066 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road, south-eastwards on A73 Carlisle Road, north-eastwards on Fernieshaw Road and north-westwards on Greenhill Road to the south-east side of the closure.

Vehicles on Greenhill Road on the south east side of the closure wishing to access Linrigg Road on the northwest side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Alternative routes will be signposted.

These works will be carried out as part of a rolling programme.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during each closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times where applicable.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 27 April, 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 21 June, 2009.

(Temporary Closures) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Hareshaw Village, Near Cleland) (Temporary Closures) Order 2009" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday the twenty seventh day of April, two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Sunday the twenty first day of June, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the upgrading of electrical cabling works) on the under noted roads by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Phase 1

Hareshaw Road over its entire length.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on A73 Carlisle Road on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Greenhill Road on the northwest side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on A73 Carlisle Road, north-eastwards on B7066 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road and south-eastwards on Linrigg Road and Greenhill Road to the northwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on Greenhill Road on the north east side of the closure wishing to access A73 Carlisle Road on the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Phase 2

Linrigg Road from the extended line of the south-eastern kerb of Hareshaw Road to the extended line of the south-east kerb of Wilsons Road.

Greenhill Road from the extended line of the south-eastern kerb of Hareshaw Road, south-eastwards, a distance of 100 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on Hareshaw Road wishing to access Linrigg Road on the north-west side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on Hareshaw Road, south-westwards on A73 Carlisle Road, north-eastwards on B7066 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road and south-eastwards on Linrigg Road to the northwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on Linrigg Road on the north-west side of the closure wishing to access Hareshaw Road should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Hareshaw Road wishing to access Greenhill Road on the south-east side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on Hareshaw Road, south-eastwards on A73 Carlisle Road, north-eastwards on Fernieshaw Road and north-westwards on Greenhill Road to the south east side of the closure.

Vehicles on Greenhill Road on the south east side of the closure wishing to access Hareshaw Road should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Linrigg Road on the north west side of the closure wishing to access Greenhill Road on the south east side of the closure should proceed north-westwards on Linrigg Road, south-westwards

on B7066 Glasgow and Edinburgh Road, south-eastwards on A73 Carlisle Road, north-eastwards on Fernieshaw Road and north-westwards on Greenhill Road to the south-east side of the closure.

Vehicles on Greenhill Road on the south east side of the closure wishing to access Linrigg Road on the northwest side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Alternative routes will be signposted.
