Craig Street, Airdrie
(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

On 15 April 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on resurfacing works) on Craig Street, Airdrie from the extended line of the southern kerb of Kennedy Drive to its junction with Victoria Place by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on Kennedy Drive, south-eastwards on Devonview Street and north-eastwards on Victoria Place to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Alternative routes will be signposted.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where practical, during the closure.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practical, during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 27 April 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 29 May 2009.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Craig Street, Airdrie) (Temporary Closure) Order 2009" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-seventh day of April, two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty-ninth day of May, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with exception of vehicles engaged on resurfacing works) on Craig Street, Airdrie from the extended line of the southern kerb of Kennedy Drive to its junction with Victoria Place by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on Kennedy Drive, south-eastwards on Devonview Street and north-eastwards on Victoria Place to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
