B802 Main Road & Main Road, Condorrat, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

On 16 April 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Power cable diversion works) on the following roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Location 1

B802 Main Road, Condorrat from the extended line of the western kerb of B802 North Road, south-westwards for a distance of 120 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling north-eastwards towards the south-west side of the closure on B802 Main Road wishing to access B802 North Road or Main Road on the north-east side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards, eastwards, northwards, westwards and south-westwards on Condorrat Ring Road to Main Road and B802 North Road on the north-east side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling south-eastwards on B802 North Road at the north-east side of the closure wishing to access B802 Main Road on the south-west side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on Main Road, north-eastwards, eastwards, southwards, westwards and north-westwards on Condorrat Ring Road to B802 Main Road on the south-west side of closure.

Vehicles travelling south-westwards on Main Road towards the north-east side of the closure wishing to access B802 Main Road on the south-west side of the closure should continue south-westwards on Main Road, proceed around the mini roundabout at the north-east side of the closure and exit north-eastwards on Main Road continuing north-eastwards, eastwards, southwards, westwards and north-westwards on Condorrat Ring Road to B802 Main Road on the south-west side of the closure.

Location 2

Main Road, Condorrat from the extended line of the eastern kerb of B802 North Road north-eastwards for a distance of 260 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling south-eastwards on B802 North Road at the south-west side of the closure wishing to access Main Road on the north-east side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on B802 Main Road, south-eastwards, eastwards, northwards, westwards and south-westwards on Condorrat Ring Road to Main Road on the north-east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to access B802 North Road at the south-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles travelling north-eastwards on B802 Main Road at the south-west side of the closure wishing to access Main Road on the north-east side of the closure should proceed

around the mini roundabout at the south-west side of the closure and exit south-westwards on B802 Main Road, continuing south-eastwards, eastwards, northwards, westwards and south-westwards on Condorrat Ring Road to Main Road on the north-east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to access B802 Main Road should proceed north-eastwards, eastwards, southwards, westwards and north-westwards on Condorrat Ring Road to B802 Main Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times during the closure.

Please note that both closures will not take place at the same time.

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 27 April 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 22 May 2009.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (B802 Main Road & Main Road, Condorrat, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Closure) Order 2009" and will be effective only when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-seventh day of April, two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty-second day of May, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Scottish Power cable diversion works) on the following roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Location 1

B802 Main Road, Condorrat from the extended line of the western kerb of B802 North Road, south-westwards for a distance of 120 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling north-eastwards towards the south-west side of the closure on B802 Main Road wishing to access B802 North Road or Main Road on the north-east side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards, eastwards, northwards, westwards and south-westwards on Condorrat Ring Road to Main Road and B802 North Road on the north-east side of the closure.

Vehicles travelling south-eastwards on B802 North Road at the north-east side of the closure wishing to access B802 Main Road on the south-west side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on Main Road, north-eastwards, eastwards, southwards, westwards and north-westwards on Condorrat Ring Road to B802 Main Road on the south-west side of closure.

Vehicles travelling south-westwards on Main Road towards the north-east side of the closure wishing to access B802 Main Road on the south-west side of the closure should continue south-westwards on Main Road, proceed around the mini roundabout at the north-east side of the closure and exit north-eastwards on Main Road continuing north-eastwards, eastwards, southwards, westwards and north-westwards on Condorrat Ring Road to B802 Main Road on the south-west side of the closure.

Location 2

Main Road, Condorrat from the extended line of the eastern kerb of B802 North Road north-eastwards for a distance of 260 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling south-eastwards on B802 North Road at the south-west side of the closure wishing to access Main Road on the north-east side of the closure

should proceed south-westwards on B802 Main Road, south-eastwards, eastwards, northwards, westwards and south-westwards on Condorrat Ring Road to Main Road on the north-east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to access B802 North Road at the south-west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles travelling north-eastwards on B802 Main Road at the south-west side of the closure wishing to access Main Road on the north-east side of the closure should proceed around the mini roundabout at the south-west side of the closure and exit south-westwards on B802 Main Road, continuing south-eastwards, eastwards, northwards, westwards and south-westwards on Condorrat Ring Road to Main Road on the north-east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north-east side of the closure wishing to access B802 Main Road should proceed north-eastwards, eastwards, southwards, westwards and north-westwards on Condorrat Ring Road to B802 Main Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times during the closure.

Please note that both closures will not take place at the same time.
