**Constarry Road, B802 Constarry Road and Barbegs Crescent, Croy**

**(Temporary Waiting Restrictions) Order 2009**

On 22 April 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 0800 hours and 1800 hours, Monday to Friday, on Constarry Road, B802 Constarry Road and Barbegs Crescent, Croy at the following locations, by reason of the likelihood of danger to the public at those locations.

- (1) the north side of Constarry Road, Croy (bounded by Holy Cross Church and St. Anne's Cottage) from the turning area at the eastern end to the parking area at the western end, a distance of 140 metres or thereby.
- (2) the south side of Constarry Road, Croy, from the turning area at the eastern end to the extended line of the eastern kerb of the access to Holy Cross Church, a distance of 70 metres or thereby.
- (3) the south side of Constarry Road, Croy from a point 7 metres east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Barbegs Crescent to the parking area at the western end, a distance of 22 metres or thereby.
- (4) both sides of Barbegs Crescent, Croy from its junction with B802 Constarry Road to a point 78 metres north of the extended line of the northern kerb of Old Mill View, including that section of road leading to 2 Barbegs Crescent, a distance of 155 metres or thereby.
- (5) both sides of B802 Constarry Road, Croy from the extended line of the northern kerb of Strath Brenning Road to a point 23 metres west of the extended line of the western kerb of Barbegs Crescent, a distance of 629 metres or thereby.

The Order will come into operation at 0800 hours on Monday, 4 May 2009 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Friday, 5 November 2010.

**Constarry Road, B802 Constarry Road and Barbegs Crescent, Croy**

**(Temporary Waiting Restrictions) Order 2009**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Constarry Road, B802 Constarry Road and Barbegs Crescent, Croy) (Temporary Waiting Restrictions) Order 2009” and shall be effective during the period from 0800 hours on Monday, the fourth day of May, Two thousand and nine until 1800 hours on Friday the fifth day of November, Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 0800 hours and 1800 hours, Monday to Friday on Constarry Road, B802 Constarry Road and Barbegs Crescent, Croy at the following locations, by reason of likelihood of danger to the public at those locations.
  - (a) the north side of Constarry Road, Croy (bounded by Holy Cross Church and St. Anne’s Cottage) from the turning area at the eastern end to the parking area at the western end, a distance of 140 metres or thereby.
  - (b) the south side of Constarry Road, Croy, from the turning area at the eastern end to the extended line of the eastern kerb of the access to Holy Cross Church, a distance of 70 metres or thereby.
  - (c) the south side of Constarry Road, Croy from a point 7 metres east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Barbegs Crescent to the parking area at the western end, a distance of 22 metres or thereby.
  - (d) both sides of Barbegs Crescent, Croy from its junction with B802 Constarry Road to a point 78 metres north of the extended line of the northern kerb of Old Mill View, including that section of road leading to 2 Barbegs Crescent, a distance of 155 metres or thereby.
  - (e) both sides of B802 Constarry Road, Croy from the extended line of the northern kerb of Strath Brennig Road to a point 23 metres west of the extended line of the western kerb of Barbegs Crescent, a distance of 629 metres or thereby.
