(Temporary 40 MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2009

On 6 May 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the construction of M80 or emergency service vehicles) on the following roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Gartferry Road, Moodiesburn from a point 358 metres or thereby east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Westdale Drive eastwards and north-eastwards to its junction with the un-named link road, a distance of 734 metres or thereby.

Un-named Link Road, Mollinsburn from the junction with Cumbernauld Road south-westwards, westwards, north-westwards and north-eastwards, to its junction with Mollins roundabout, a distance of 541 metres or thereby.

Lindsaybeg Road, Chryston from a point 71 metres or thereby west of the extended line of the western kerb of Peathill Avenue westwards then north-westwards to its junction with Burnbrae Road, a distance of 807 metres or thereby.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 18 May 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 12 November 2010.

(Temporary 40 MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Roads, Northern Area) (Temporary 40 MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2009" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the eighteenth day of May, two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Friday, the twelfth day of November, Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the construction of M80 or emergency service vehicles) on the following roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Gartferry Road, Moodiesburn from a point 358 metres or thereby east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Westdale Drive eastwards and north-eastwards to its junction with the un-named link road, a distance of 734 metres or thereby.

Un-named Link Road, Mollinsburn from the junction with Cumbernauld Road south-westwards, westwards, north-westwards and north-eastwards, to its junction with Mollins roundabout, a distance of 541 metres or thereby.

Lindsaybeg Road, Chryston from a point 71 metres or thereby west of the extended line of the western kerb of Peathill Avenue westwards then north-westwards to its junction with Burnbrae Road, a distance of 807 metres or thereby.
