

**North Lanarkshire Council**  
**Crowwood Drive, Airdrie**  
**(Temporary Closure) Order 2009**

On 27 May 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge strengthening works) on Crowwood Drive, Airdrie from a point 49 metres south of its junction with Clarkston Drive south-eastwards to a point 110 metres north-west of its junction with Bankhead Avenue, a distance of 80 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south-east side of the closure should proceed northwards on Crowwood Drive, westwards on Clarkston Drive, northwards on Castle Road, westwards on A89 Forrest Street, southwards on A73 Carlisle Road, south-eastwards and north-eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, south-eastwards and north-eastwards on Willow Drive, north-westwards then north-eastwards on Bankhead Avenue and north-westwards on Crowwood Drive to the south-east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the south-east side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0700 hours on Monday, 8 June 2009 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Sunday, 11 October 2009.

**(Temporary Closure) Order 2009**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Crowwood Drive, Airdrie) (Temporary Closure) Order 2009" and shall be effective during the period from 0700 hours on Monday, the eighth day of June, two thousand and nine until 1800 hours on Sunday, the eleventh day of October, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge strengthening works) on Crowwood Drive, Airdrie from a point 49 metres south of its junction with Clarkston Drive south-eastwards to a point 110 metres north-west of its junction with Bankhead Avenue, a distance of 80 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south-east side of the closure should proceed northwards on Crowwood Drive, westwards on Clarkston Drive, northwards on Castle Road, westwards on A89 Forrest Street, southwards on A73 Carlisle Road, south-eastwards and north-eastwards on Craigneuk Avenue, south-eastwards and north-eastwards on Willow Drive, north-westwards then north-eastwards on Bankhead Avenue and north-westwards on Crowwood Drive to the south-east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the south-east side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.
