Un-named Footpath from Eastfield Road to Rigghead Avenue and Roadside, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2009

On 3 June 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on footbridge refurbishment works) on the footpath between Eastfield Road and Roadside, Cumbernauld from its junction with Eastfield Road to its junction with Rigghead Avenue and Roadside by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on Eastfield Road on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on Eastfield Road, southwards then eastwards on Old Dullatur Road and north-eastwards then northwards on Roadside, to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on Roadside on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0600 hours on Monday, 15 June 2009 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Sunday, 6 September 2009.

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Un-named Footpath from Eastfield Road to Rigghead Avenue and Roadside, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2009” and shall be effective during the period from 0600 hours on Monday, the fifteenth day of June, two thousand and nine until 1800 hours on Sunday, the sixth day of September, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on footbridge refurbishment works) on the footpath between Eastfield Road and Roadside, Cumbernauld from its junction with Eastfield Road to its junction with Rigghead Avenue and Roadside by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on Eastfield Road on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on Eastfield Road, southwards then eastwards on Old Dullatur Road and north-eastwards then northwards on Roadside, to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on Roadside on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
