Unnamed Footpath from B816 Castlecary Road to Wardpark Road, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2009

On 10 June 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on footbridge works associated with the construction of the M80) on the footbridge from its junction with the B816 Castlecary Road to its junction with Wardpark Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on B816 Castlecary Road on the north side of the closure wishing to access Wardpark Road on the south side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on B816 Castlecary Road, south-eastwards on the northwest side of Forest Road, south-eastwards on the east side of Forest Road, south-eastwards to southwest side of Forest Road to Wardpark Road.

Pedestrians on Wardpark Road on the south side of the closure wishing to access B816 Castlecary Road should proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0600 hours on Monday, 22 June 2009 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Sunday, 22 November 2009.

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Unnamed Footpath from B816 Castlecary Road to Wardpark Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2009" and shall be effective during the period from 0600 hours on Monday, the twenty second day of June, two thousand and nine until 1800 hours on Sunday, the twenty second day of November, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on footbridge works associated with the construction of the M80) on the footbridge from its junction with the B816 Castlecary Road to its junction with Wardpark Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on B816 Castlecary Road on the north side of the closure wishing to access Wardpark Road on the south side of the closure should proceed north-eastwards on B816 Castlecary Road, south-eastwards on the northwest side of Forest Road, south-eastwards on the east side of Forest Road and south-eastwards on the southwest side of Forest Road to Wardpark Road.

Pedestrians on Wardpark Road on the south side of the closure wishing to access B816 Castlecary Road should proceed vice versa.
