

**North Lanarkshire Council**  
**Foulburn Road, Allanton**  
**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2009**

On 10 June 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on repairs to the rail bridge) on Foulburn Road from a point 100 metres or thereby west of the rail bridge eastwards for a distance of 160 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed eastwards then south-eastwards on Foulburn Road, south-westwards on Mill Road, eastwards on Allanton Road, south-westwards and north-westwards on the A71 Morningside Road, north-westwards on the A73 Westwood Road, south-eastwards on Carlisle Road, north-eastwards and eastwards on Shawstonfoot Road and north-eastwards and south-eastwards on Foulburn Road to the west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, which will be effective only when signing is in place, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 22 June 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 17 July 2009.

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2009**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Foulburn Road, Allanton) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2009” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty second day of June, two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Friday, the seventeenth day of July, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on repairs to the rail bridge) on Foulburn Road from a point 100 metres or thereby west of the rail bridge eastwards for a distance of 160 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed eastwards then south-eastwards on Foulburn Road, south-westwards on Mill Road, eastwards on Allanton Road, south-westwards and north-westwards on the A71 Morningside Road, north-westwards on the A73 Westwood Road, south-eastwards on Carlisle Road, north-eastwards and eastwards on Shawstonfoot Road and north-eastwards and south-eastwards on Foulburn Road to the west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
