Wilderness Brae and Forest Road, Cumbernauld

(Temporary 30 MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2009

On 17 June 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Bridge Works associated with the construction of the M80) on the following roads by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

A8011 Wilderness Brae, Cumbernauld both northbound and southbound carriageways from their junctions with Old Inn's Roundabout southwards for a distance of 250 metres or thereby.

Forest Road, Cumbernauld both north-westbound and south-eastbound carriageways from their junctions with Wardpark Roundabout south-eastwards for a distance of 238 metres or thereby.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 29 June 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 12 November 2010.

(Temporary 30 MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Wilderness Brae and Forest Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary 30 MPH Speed Restriction) Order 2009” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty ninth day of June two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Friday, the twelfth day of November , Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Bridge Works associated with the construction of the M80) on the following roads by reason of works being executed on or near that location:

A8011 Wilderness Brae, Cumbernauld both northbound and southbound carriageways from their junctions with Old Inn’s Roundabout southwards for a distance of 250 metres or thereby.

Forest Road, Cumbernauld both north-westbound and south-eastbound carriageways from their junctions with Wardpark Roundabout south-eastwards for a distance of 238 metres or thereby.
