(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2009

On 17 June 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage works) on Broomknoll Street between the extended line of the southern kerb of A89 Weaver Road and the extended line of the northern kerb of Victoria Place by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed eastwards on A89 Weaver Road, southwards on Gartlea Road, westwards on Hogg Street and north-westwards on B802 Cairnhill Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0600 hours on Monday, 29 June 2009 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Sunday, 12 July 2009.
