Ryde Lane, Wishaw

(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2009

On 1 July 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on lighting upgrade works) on Ryde Lane, Wishaw from its junction with Ryde Road, north-eastwards for a distance of 195 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative Routes: Pedestrians on the southwest side of the closure wishing to access the northeast side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on Ryde Road, south-eastwards then north-eastwards on Waverley Drive, north-westwards on Coltness Road and south-westwards on Ryde Lane to the northeast side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the northeast side of the closure wishing to access the southwest side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 13 July 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 14 August 2009.

(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Ryde Lane, Wishaw) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2009” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the thirteenth day of July, Two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Friday, the fourteenth day of August, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on lighting upgrade works) on Ryde Lane, Wishaw from its junction with Ryde Road, north-eastwards for a distance of 195 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative Routes: Pedestrians on the southwest side of the closure wishing to access the northeast side of the closure should proceed south-westwards on Ryde Road, south-eastwards then north-eastwards on Waverley Drive, north-westwards on Coltness Road and south-westwards on Ryde Lane to the northeast side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the northeast side of the closure wishing to access the southwest side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
