

North Lanarkshire Council
Whinhall Road, Airdrie
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2009

On 1 July 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on water main installations) on Whinhall Road from its junction with Wilson Street to the extended line of the southern kerb of Burniebrae by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the southeast side of the closure wishing to access the northwest side of the closure should proceed south-eastwards on Wilson Street, south-westwards on Mavisbank Street, north-westwards then north-eastwards on Burnfoot Drive and south-eastwards on Whinhall Road to the northwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on the northwest side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0600 hours on Monday, 13 July 2009 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Sunday, 16 August 2009.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Whinhall Road, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2009” and shall be effective during the period from 0600 hours on Monday, the thirteenth day of July, Two thousand and nine until 1800 hours on Sunday, the sixteenth day of August, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on water main installations) on Whinhall Road from its junction with Wilson Street to the extended line of the southern kerb of Burniebrae by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the southeast side of the closure wishing to access the northwest side of the closure should proceed southeastwards on Wilson Street, southwestwards on Mavisbank Street, northwestwards then northeastwards on Burnfoot Drive and southeastwards on Whinhall Road to the northwest side of the closure.

Vehicles on the northwest side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
