(Temporary 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2009

On 17 July 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour from a point 50 metres or thereby south west of the extended line of the south western end of Muirhall Terrace to a point 140 metres or thereby north east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of the north eastern end of Muirhall Terrace by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Appropriate signage will be in place advising drivers of the new speed limit.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Friday, 31 July 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 31 January 2010.

(Temporary 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Hirst Road, Salsburgh) (Temporary 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2009" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Friday, thirty first day of July, Two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Sunday, thirty first day of January, Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour from a point 50 metres or thereby south west of the extended line of the south western end of Muirhall Terrace to a point 140 metres or thereby north east of the extended line of the eastern kerb of the north eastern end of Muirhall Terrace by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Appropriate signage will be in place advising drivers of the new speed limit.
