Tomtain Brae, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2009

On 22 July 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on embankment refurbishment works) on the following footpaths by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Location 1

The un-named footpath along the north kerblineline of Westfield Primary School over its entire length.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed north eastwards and northwards on the un-named footpath to the west of Nos 29-35 Tomtain Brae, continue north eastwards on the footpath to its connection with the un-named footpath at Tomtain Court, southwards, eastwards, north eastwards and eastwards to the footpath between Nos 17 and 19 Tomtain Court, southwards on the un-named footpath and westwards through the pond on Westfield Drive to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Location 2

The un-named footpath to the west of Nos 29 - 35 Tomtain Brae from its junction with the un-named footpath at the north kerblineline of the Westfield Primary School, north westwards for a distance of 11 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed northwards on the un-named footpath to the west of Nos 29-35 Tomtain Brae, continue north eastwards on the footpath to its connection with the un-named footpath at Tomtain Court, southwards, eastwards, north eastwards and eastwards to the footpath between Nos 17 and 19 Tomtain Court, southwards on the un-named footpath and westwards through the pond on Westfield Drive to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Location 3

The un-named footpath between Nos 17 & 11 Tomtain Brae from its junction with the un-named footpath at the north kerblineline of the Westfield Primary School, northwards for a distance of 19 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed north eastwards and northwards to the un-named footpath at Tomtain Court, southwards, eastwards, north eastwards and eastwards to the footpath between Nos 17 and 19 Tomtain Court, southwards on the un-named footpath and westwards through the pond on Westfield Drive to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Location 4

The un-named footpath between Nos 10 & 35 Tomtain Court from its junction with the un-named footpath at the north kerbline of the Westfield Primary School, northwards for a distance of 10 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed north eastwards and eastwards to the footpath between Nos 17 & 19 Tomtain Court, southwards on the un-named footpath and westwards through the pend on Westfield Drive to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 3 August 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 28 August 2009.

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Tomtain Brae, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2009” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the third day of August, two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty-eighth day of August, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on embankment refurbishment works) on the following footpaths by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Location 1

The un-named footpath along the north kerbline of Westfield Primary School over its entire length.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed north eastwards and northwards on the un-named footpath to the west of No's 29-35 Tomtain Brae, continue north eastwards on the footpath to its connection with the un-named footpath at Tomtain Court, southwards, eastwards, north eastwards and eastwards to the footpath between N's 17 and 19 Tomtain Court, southwards on the un-named footpath and westwards through the pend on Westfield Drive to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Location 2

The un-named footpath to the west of Nos 29 - 35 Tomtain Brae from its junction with the un-named footpath at the north kerbline of the Westfield Primary School, north westwards for a distance of 11 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed northwards on the un-named footpath to the west of Nos 29-35 Tomtain Brae, continue north eastwards on the footpath to its connection with the un-named footpath at Tomtain Court, southwards, eastwards, north eastwards and eastwards to the footpath between Nos 17 and 19 Tomtain Court, southwards on the un-named footpath and westwards through the pend on Westfield Drive to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Location 3

The un-named footpath between Nos 17 & 11 Tomtain Brae from its junction with the un-named footpath at the north kerbline of the Westfield Primary School, northwards for a distance of 19 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed north eastwards and northwards to the un-named footpath at Tomtain Court, southwards, eastwards, north eastwards and eastwards to the footpath between Nos 17 and 19

Tomtain Court, southwards on the un-named footpath and westwards through the pend on Westfield Drive to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Location 4

The un-named footpath between Nos 10 & 35 Tomtain Court from its junction with the un-named footpath at the north kerblineline of the Westfield Primary School, northwards for a distance of 10 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed north eastwards and eastwards to the footpath between Nos 17 & 19 Tomtain Court, southwards on the un-named footpath and westwards through the pend on Westfield Drive to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
