

North Lanarkshire Council
Caledonian Road, Wishaw
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2009

On 2 September 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on cabling works) on Caledonian Road, Wishaw from the extended line of the southern kerb of Millbank Road, south westwards to the extended line of the northern kerb of Netherton Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Caledonian Road, north westwards on Alexander Street, south westwards on Netherton Street and south eastwards on Netherton Road to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 14 September 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 11 October 2009.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Caledonian Road, Wishaw) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2009" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the fourteenth day of September, Two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Sunday, the eleventh day of October, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on cabling works) on Caledonian Road, Wishaw from the extended line of the southern kerb of Millbank Road, south westwards to the extended line of the northern kerb of Netherton Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Caledonian Road, north westwards on Alexander Street, south westwards on Netherton Street and south eastwards on Netherton Road to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.
