A73 Carlisle Road and Access Road to Stirling Road Industrial Estate, Chapelhall

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2009

On 16 September 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing) on the undernoted access road and at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the undernoted road by reason of works being executed on or near the following locations.

Road Closure

Access road to Chapelhall Industrial Estate, Chapelhall, from its junction with A73 Carlisle Road, eastwards to its junction with Stirling Road, Chapelhall.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure travelling south eastwards wishing to gain access to Chapelhall Industrial Estate should continue south eastwards on A73 Carlisle Road then north eastwards on Burniebrae Road and westwards on Roseberry Road to the Industrial Estate.

Vehicles on A73 Main Street travelling north westwards towards Chapelhall Industrial Estate proposing to gain access via the access road should proceed north eastwards on Burniebrae Road and westwards on Roseberry Road to the Industrial Estate.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access A73 Carlisle Road should proceed north eastwards on Burns Road, south eastwards on Roseberry Road and south westwards on Burniebrae Road to A73 Carlisle Road.

Alternative route(s) will be signposted.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the closure.

Speed Restriction

A73 Carlisle Road, Chapelhall from the extended line of the northern kerb of Burniebrae Road, north westwards for a distance of 550 metres or thereby.

The Order, which will be effective only on Sundays from 0001 hours and 2359 hours, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Sunday, 4 October 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 8 November 2009.

A73 Carlisle Road and Access Road to Stirling Road Industrial Estate, Chapelhall

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (A73 Carlisle Road and Access Road to Stirling Road Industrial Estate, Chapelhall) (Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2009" and shall be effective on Sundays only, during the period from 0001 hours on Sunday, the fourth day of October, two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Sunday, the eighth day of November, Two thousand and nine.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing) on the undernoted access road and at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the undernoted road by reason of works being executed on or near the following locations.

Road Closure

Access road to Chapelhall Industrial Estate, Chapelhall, from its junction with A73 Carlisle Road, eastwards to its junction with Stirling Road, Chapelhall.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure travelling south eastwards wishing to gain access to Chapelhall Industrial Estate should continue south eastwards on A73 Carlisle Road then north eastwards on Burniebrae Road and westwards on Roseberry Road to the Industrial Estate.

Vehicles on A73 Main Street travelling north westwards towards Chapelhall Industrial Estate proposing to gain access via the access road should proceed north eastwards on Burniebrae Road and westwards on Roseberry Road to the Industrial Estate.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access A73 Carlisle Road should proceed north eastwards on Burns Road, south eastwards on Roseberry Road and south westwards on Burniebrae Road to A73 Carlisle Road.

Alternative route(s) will be signposted.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the closure.

Speed Restriction

A73 Carlisle Road, Chapelhall from the extended line of the northern kerb of Burniebrae Road, north westwards for a distance of 550 metres or thereby.
