B816 Castlecary Road and Dunns Wood Road, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2009

On 11 November 2009 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on bridge works associated with the construction of the M80) on the footpath from its junction with B816 Castlecary Road to its junction with Dunns Wood Road, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on B816 Castlecary Road, south eastwards on Forest Road and north eastwards on Dunns Wood Road to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 23 November 2009 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 25 April 2010.

(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2009

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (B816 Castlecary Road and Dunns Wood Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2009” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty third day of November, Two thousand and nine until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty fifth day of April, Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on bridge works associated with the construction of the M80) on the footpath from its junction with B816 Castlecary Road to its junction with Dunns Wood Road, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on B816 Castlecary Road, south eastwards on Forest Road and north eastwards on Dunns Wood Road to the south east side of the closure.

Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
