(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010

On 13 January 2010 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main works) on Glenhove Road, Luggiebank from a point 580 metres east of the junction with Stirling Road to a point 500 metres east of the junction with Stirling Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed eastwards, southwards on Glenhove Road, south westwards on Hulks Road, north eastwards on Stirling Road and eastwards on Glenhove Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0600 hours on Monday, 25 January 2010 and will remain in operation until 1800 hours on Friday, 26 February 2010.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Glenhove Road, Luggiebank) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010" and shall be effective during the period from 0600 hours on Monday, the twenty fifth day of January, Two thousand and ten until 1800 hours on Friday, the twenty sixth day of February, Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main works) on Glenhove Road, Luggiebank from a point 580 metres east of the junction with Stirling Road to a point 500 metres east of the junction with Stirling Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed eastwards, southwards on Glenhove Road, south westwards on Hulks Road, north eastwards on Stirling Road and eastwards on Glenhove Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
