

**North Lanarkshire Council**  
**Hill Terrace & Thorndean Avenue, Carfin**  
**(Temporary Closures) Order 2010**

On 27 January 2010 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage works) on the under-noted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

**Location 1**

Hill Terrace, Carfin from its junction with Thorndean Avenue, south eastwards for a distance of 95 metres or thereby.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Hill Terrace, south westwards on Newarthill Road, north westwards on Hatton Terrace then north eastwards on Thorndean Avenue to the north west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

**Location 2**

Thorndean Avenue, Carfin from the extended line of the south western kerb of Hatton Terrace, north eastwards to the extended line of the north eastern kerb of Hill Terrace.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on Thorndean Avenue on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Hill Terrace should proceed south westwards on Thorndean Avenue, north westwards on Leven Terrace, south westwards on Woodrow Avenue, south eastwards on New Stevenston Road and north eastwards on Newarthill Road to Hill Terrace.*

*Vehicles on Hill Terrace wishing to access Thorndean Avenue on the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Thorndean Avenue on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Hatton Terrace on the west side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Thorndean Avenue, north westwards on Leven Terrace and north eastwards on Woodrow Avenue to Hatton Terrace.*

*Vehicles on Hatton Terrace on the west side of the closure wishing to access Thorndean Avenue on the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Thorndean Avenue on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Hatton Terrace on the east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Thorndean Avenue, north westwards on Leven Terrace, south westwards on Woodrow Avenue, south eastwards on New Stevenston Road and north eastwards on Newarthill Road to Hatton Terrace.*

*Vehicles on Hatton Terrace on the east side of the closure wishing to access Thorndean Avenue on the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Hatton Terrace on the east side of the closure wishing to access Hill Terrace should proceed south eastwards on Hatton Terrace and north eastwards on Newarthill Road to Hill Terrace.*

*Vehicles on Hill Terrace wishing to access Hatton Terrace on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Hatton Terrace on the east side of the closure wishing to access Hatton Terrace on the west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Hatton Terrace, south westwards on Newarthill Road, north westwards on New Stevenston Road and north eastwards on Woodrow Avenue to Hatton Terrace.*

*Vehicles on Hatton Terrace on the west side of the closure wishing to access Hatton Terrace on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Hill Terrace on the east side of the closure wishing to access Hatton Terrace on the west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Hill Terrace, south westwards on Newarthill Road, north westwards on New Stevenston Road and north eastwards on Woodrow Avenue to Hatton Terrace.*

*Vehicles on Hatton Terrace on the west side of the closure wishing to access Hill Terrace on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

The County of Lanark (Hatton Terrace-Newarthill Road, Carfin) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1967 is revoked in its entirety as part of this Order.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, where practicable, during the closure.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturday, 13 February 2010 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Thursday, 18 March 2010.

**Hill Terrace & Thorndean Avenue, Carfin**  
**(Temporary Closures) Order 2010**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Hill Terrace & Thorndean Avenue, Carfin) (Temporary Closures) Order 2010” and shall be effective only when displayed by signs, during the period from 0001 hours on Saturday, the thirteenth day of February, Two thousand and ten until 2359 hours on Thursday, the eighteenth day of March, Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage works) on the under-noted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

**Location 1**

Hill Terrace, Carfin from its junction with Thorndean Avenue, south eastwards for a distance of 95 metres or thereby.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Hill Terrace, south westwards on Newarthill Road, north westwards on Hatton Terrace then north eastwards on Thorndean Avenue to the north west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

**Location 2**

Thorndean Avenue, Carfin from the extended line of the south western kerb of Hatton Terrace, north eastwards to the extended line of the north eastern kerb of Hill Terrace.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on Thorndean Avenue on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Hill Terrace should proceed south westwards on Thorndean Avenue, north westwards on Leven Terrace, south westwards on Woodrow Avenue, south eastwards on New Stevenston Road and north eastwards on Newarthill Road to Hill Terrace.*

*Vehicles on Hill Terrace wishing to access Thorndean Avenue on the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Thorndean Avenue on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Hatton Terrace on the west side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Thorndean Avenue, north westwards on Leven Terrace and north eastwards on Woodrow Avenue to Hatton Terrace.*

*Vehicles on Hatton Terrace on the west side of the closure wishing to access Thorndean Avenue on the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Thorndean Avenue on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Hatton Terrace on the east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Thorndean Avenue, north westwards on Leven Terrace, south westwards on Woodrow Avenue, south eastwards on New Stevenston Road and north eastwards on Newarthill Road to Hatton Terrace.*

*Vehicles on Hatton Terrace on the east side of the closure wishing to access Thorndean Avenue on the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Hatton Terrace on the east side of the closure wishing to access Hill Terrace should proceed south eastwards on Hatton Terrace and north eastwards on Newarthill Road to Hill Terrace.*

*Vehicles on Hill Terrace wishing to access Hatton Terrace on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Hatton Terrace on the east side of the closure wishing to access Hatton Terrace on the west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Hatton Terrace, south westwards on Newarthill Road, north westwards on New Stevenston Road and north eastwards on Woodrow Avenue to Hatton Terrace.*

*Vehicles on Hatton Terrace on the west side of the closure wishing to access Hatton Terrace on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on Hill Terrace on the east side of the closure wishing to access Hatton Terrace on the west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Hill Terrace, south westwards on Newarthill Road, north westwards on New Stevenston Road and north eastwards on Woodrow Avenue to Hatton Terrace.*

*Vehicles on Hatton Terrace on the west side of the closure wishing to access Hill Terrace on the east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

The County of Lanark (Hatton Terrace-Newarthill Road, Carfin) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1967 will be revoked in its entirety as part of this Order.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, where practicable, during the closure.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.
