

North Lanarkshire Council
Main Street, Bellshill
(Temporary Closure) Order 2010

On 3 February 2010 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on Main Street, Bellshill from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Motherwell Road, eastwards, to the extended line of the western kerb of Emma Jay Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed eastwards on Main Street, southwards on Thorn Road, north westwards, south westwards then westwards on John Street and northwards on Motherwell Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises for loading etc will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where applicable, during the closure.

Appropriate signing will be in place advising drivers of the restrictions during the closure.

The Order, which will be effective only when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 15 February 2010 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 14 March 2010.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Main Street, Bellshill) (Temporary Closure) Order 2010" and shall be effective only when displayed by signs during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the fifteenth day of February, two thousand and ten until 2359 hours on Sunday, the fourteenth day of March, Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on Main Street, Bellshill from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Motherwell Road, eastwards, to the extended line of the western kerb of Emma Jay Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed eastwards on Main Street, southwards on Thorn Road, north westwards, south westwards then westwards on John Street and northwards on Motherwell Road to the west side of the closure.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises for loading etc will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, where applicable, during the closure.

Appropriate signing will be in place advising drivers of the restrictions during the closure.
