**Un-named Footpath from Eastfield Road to Rigghead Avenue and Roadside, Cumbernauld**

**(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2010**

On 4 March 2010 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on footbridge refurbishment works) on the footpath between Eastfield Road and Roadside, Cumbernauld from its junction with Eastfield Road to its junction with Rigghead Avenue and Roadside by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Pedestrians on Eastfield Road on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Eastfield Road, southwards then eastwards on Old Dullatur Road and north eastwards then northwards on Roadside, to the south east side of the closure.*

*Pedestrians on Roadside on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 15 March 2010 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Wednesday, 30 June 2010.

**(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2010**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Un-named Footpath from Eastfield Road to Rigghead Avenue and Roadside, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order 2010” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the fifteenth day of March, two thousand and ten until 2359 hours on Wednesday, the thirtieth day of June Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on footbridge refurbishment works) on the footpath between Eastfield Road and Roadside, Cumbernauld from its junction with Eastfield Road to its junction with Rigghead Avenue and Roadside by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Pedestrians on Eastfield Road on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Eastfield Road, southwards then eastwards on Old Dullatur Road and north eastwards then northwards on Roadside, to the south east side of the closure.*

*Pedestrians on Roadside on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*
