**B8054 Lye Brae Footbridge, Cumbernauld**

**(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2010**

On 24 March 2010 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of a pedestrian engaged on footbridge refurbishment work) on the footbridge over B8054 Lye Brae, Cumbernauld from its junction with Tarbolton Road to its junction with Glenhove Road (North) by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Pedestrians on Tarbolton Road on the north east side of the closure wishing to access Glenhove Road (North) on the south west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on the unnamed footpath to Clouden Road, south westwards across the footbridge over the B8054 Lye Brae to Glenhove Road (South) and proceed north westwards to Glenhove Road (North) to the south west side of the closure.*

*Pedestrians on Glenhove Road (North) on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Tarbolton Road on the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 12 April 2010 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 29 August 2010.

**(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2010**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restriction) Act 1991), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

- (1) This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (B8054 Lye Brae Footbridge, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2010" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the Twelfth day of April, Two Thousand and Ten until 2359 hours on Sunday, the Twenty ninth day of August, Two Thousand and Ten.
- (2) No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of a pedestrian engaged on footbridge refurbishment works) on the footbridge over B8054 Lye Brae, Cumbernauld from its junction with Tarbolton Road to its junction with Glenhove Road (North) by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Pedestrians on Tarbolton Road on the north east side of the closure wishing to access Glenhove Road (North) on the south west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on the unnamed footpath to Clouden Road, south westwards across the footbridge over the B8054 Lye Brae to Glenhove Road (South) and proceed north westwards to Glenhove Road (North) to the south west side of the closure.*

*Pedestrians on Glenhove Road (North) on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Tarbolton Road on the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*
