Dryburgh Road, Wishaw

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010

On 5 May 2010 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on junction improvements) north eastwards on Dryburgh Road, Wishaw from its junction with Main Street, Wishaw north eastwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles 7.5 tonnes or less in weight travelling south eastwards on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should continue south eastwards on Main Street, north eastwards then northwards on Kenilworth Avenue, westwards on Waverley Drive and south eastwards on Dryburgh Road to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles in excess of 7.5 tonnes in weight travelling south eastwards on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should continue south eastwards on Main Street, north eastwards on Kirk Road, north westwards and northwards on Coltness Road, south westwards and southwards on North Dryburgh Road and south eastwards on Dryburgh Road to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles 7.5 tonnes or less in weight travelling north westwards on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should continue north westwards on Main Street, south westwards on Glasgow Road, proceed around the Heathery Roundabout exiting and proceeding north eastwards on Glasgow Road, south eastwards on Main Street, north eastwards then northwards on Kenilworth Avenue, westwards on Waverley Drive and south eastwards on Dryburgh Road to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles in excess of 7.5 tonnes in weight travelling north westwards on the south west of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should continue north westwards on Main Street, south westwards on Glasgow Road, proceed around the Heathery Roundabout exiting and proceeding north eastwards on Glasgow Road, south eastwards on Main Street, north eastwards on Kirk Road, north westwards and northwards on Coltness Road, south westwards and southwards on North Dryburgh Road and south eastwards on Dryburgh Road to the north east side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times where applicable.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 24 May 2010 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 18 June 2010.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restriction) Act 1991), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

- (1) This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Dryburgh Road, Wishaw) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty fourth day of May, Two thousand and ten until 2359 hours on Friday, the eighteenth day of June, Two thousand and ten.
- (2) No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on junction improvements) north eastwards on Dryburgh Road, Wishaw from its junction with Main Street, Wishaw north eastwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles 7.5 tonnes or less in weight travelling south eastwards on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should continue south eastwards on Main Street, north eastwards then northwards on Kenilworth Avenue, westwards on Waverley Drive and south eastwards on Dryburgh Road to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles in excess of 7.5 tonnes in weight travelling south eastwards on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should continue south eastwards on Main Street, north eastwards on Kirk Road, north westwards and northwards on Coltness Road, south westwards and southwards on North Dryburgh Road and south eastwards on Dryburgh Road to the north east side of the closure.

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Vehicles in excess of 7.5 tonnes in weight travelling north westwards on the south west of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should continue north westwards on Main Street, south westwards on Glasgow Road, proceed around the Heathery Roundabout exiting and proceeding north eastwards on Glasgow Road, south eastwards on Main Street, north eastwards on Kirk Road, north westwards and northwards on Coltness Road, south westwards and southwards on North Dryburgh Road and south eastwards on Dryburgh Road to the north east side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times where applicable.
