A8011 Wilderness Brae, Cumbernauld
(Temporary 30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2010

On 19 May 2010 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on A8011 Wilderness Brae, Cumbernauld from its junction with Old Inch Roundabout, southwards for a distance of 750 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 7 June 2010 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 24 December 2010.

(Temporary 30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2010

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restriction) Act 1991), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

- (1) This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (A8011 Wilderness Brae, Cumbernauld) (Temporary 30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2010" and be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the seventh day of June, Two thousand and ten until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty fourth day of December, Two thousand and ten.
- (2) No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on A8011 Wilderness Brae, Cumbernauld from its junction with Old Inch Roundabout, southwards for a distance of 750 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.
