Chapelknowe Road, Carfin

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010

On 16 June 2010 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on underground cable reinforcement works) on Chapelknowe Road, Carfin from a point 300 metres east of its junction with Newarthill Road, eastwards for a distance of 380 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed westwards on Chapelknowe Road, north eastwards on Newarthill Road, Carfin Road and High Street, south eastwards on Biggar Road, south westwards on Main Street, north westwards on Omoa Road and south westwards on Chapelknowe Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 5 July 2010 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 8 August 2010.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Chapelknowe Road, Carfin) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the fifth day of July, Two thousand and ten until 2359 hours on Sunday, the eighth day of August, Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on underground cable reinforcement works) on Chapelknowe Road, Carfin from a point 300 metres east of its junction with Newarthill Road, eastwards for a distance of 380 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed westwards on Chapelknowe Road, north eastwards on Newarthill Road, Carfin Road and High Street, south eastwards on Biggar Road, south westwards on Main Street, north westwards on Omoa Road and south westwards on Chapelknowe Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.
