

North Lanarkshire Council
Thrashbush Road, Wishaw
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010

On 30 June 2010 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer installation works) on Thrashbush Road, Wishaw from its junction with Cambusnethan Street to the extended line of the southern kerb of Mossneuk Park by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Cambusnethan Street, northwards on Branchal Road, south westwards on Northmuir Drive and southwards on Thrashbush Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 19 July 2010 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 13 August 2010.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Thrashbush Road, Wishaw) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the nineteenth day of July, Two thousand and ten until 2359 hours on Sunday, the thirteenth day of August, Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer installation works) on Thrashbush Road, Wishaw from its junction with Cambusnethan Street to the extended line of the southern kerb of Mossneuk Park by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Cambusnethan Street, northwards on Branchal Road, south westwards on Northmuir Drive and southwards on Thrashbush Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.
