**Unnamed Footpath between Eastfield Road, Rigghead Avenue and Roadside,
Cumbernauld**

(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order No 2 2010

On 29 September 2010 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on bridge works associated with the construction of the M80) on the Unnamed Footpath between its junction with Eastfield Road and its junction with Rigghead Avenue and Roadside, Cumbernauld by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Eastfield Road, southwards across the traffic refuge island to Old Dullatur Road, south eastwards on Old Dullatur Road and north eastwards on Roadside to the end of the diversion.

Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

The Order, which continues the restrictions currently in operation at this location by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Wednesday, 28 July 2010 will come into operation at 2359 hours on Monday, 18 October 2010 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 24 December 2010.

(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order No 2 2010

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Unnamed Footpath between Eastfield Road, Rigghead Avenue and Roadside, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order No 2 2010" which continues the restrictions currently in operation at this location by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Wednesday, 28 July 2010 and shall be effective during the period from 2359 hours on Monday, the eighteenth day of October, Two thousand and ten until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty fourth day of December, Two thousand and ten.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on bridge works associated with the construction of the M80) on the Unnamed Footpath between its junction with Eastfield Road and its junction with Rigghead Avenue and Roadside, Cumbernauld by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Pedestrians on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Eastfield Road, southwards across the traffic refuge island to Old Dullatur Road, south eastwards on Old Dullatur Road and north eastwards on Roadside to the end of the diversion.

Pedestrians on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
