Callon Street - Airdrie
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010

On 27 October 2010 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on installation of ducting and power cable) on Callon Street, Airdrie from its junction with A89 Weaver Road to its junction with B802 Broomknoll Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: There are no alternative routes.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times where applicable.

The Order, which will be effective only on Sundays between 0001 hours and 2359 hours, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Sunday, 14 November 2010 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 28 November 2010 and only when displayed by signs.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Callon Street - Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2010” and shall only be effective on Sundays between 0001 hours and 2359 hours, and will come into operation during the period from 0001 hours on Sunday, the fourteenth day of November, Two thousand and ten until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty eighth day of November, Two thousand and ten and only when displayed by signs.

2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on installation of ducting and power cable) on Callon Street, Airdrie from its junction with A89 Weaver Road to its junction with B802 Broomknoll Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: There are no alternative routes.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times where applicable.
