Victoria Place, Airdrie

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2011

On 19 January 2011 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on ground stabilisation works in the advance of the installation of a new sewage system) on the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Phase 1

Victoria Place, Airdrie from the extended line of the western kerb of Martyn Street, north eastwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Rochsolloch Farm Cottages.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Victoria Place, north westwards on Rochsolloch Road, north eastwards on A89 Deedes Street and A89 Alexander Street, south eastwards then eastwards on A89 Weavers Road, southwards on Broomknoll Street, and south westwards on Victoria Place to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Martyn Street wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Martyn Street, north westwards and south westwards on Kippen Street, south eastwards on Rochsolloch Road and north eastwards on Victoria Place to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Martyn Street should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Martyn Street wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Martyn Street, north eastwards on Kennedy Drive, south eastwards on Devonview Street and south westwards on Victoria Place to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access Martyn Street should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Viewfield wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed northwards then north eastwards on Viewfield, northwards on Menzies Lane, south westwards on Kennedy Drive, south eastwards on Martyn Street, north westwards then south westwards on Kippen Street, south eastwards on Rochsolloch Road and north eastwards on Victoria Place to the south west side of the closure

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Viewfield should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Viewfield wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed north westwards then north eastwards on Viewfield, northwards on Menzies Lane, north eastwards on Kennedy Drive, south eastwards on Devonview Street and south westwards on Victoria Place to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access Viewfield should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Victoria Crescent wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards then north eastwards on Victoria Crescent, north westwards on Devonview Street, north eastwards on Victoria Place, northwards on Broomknoll Street, westwards then north westwards on A89 Weavers Road, south westwards on A89 Alexander Street and A89 Deedes Street, south eastwards on Rochsolloch Road and north eastwards on Victoria Place to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Victoria Crescent should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Martyn Street wishing to access Viewfield should proceed north westwards on Martyn Street, north eastwards on Kennedy Drive and south eastwards on Menzies Lane to Viewfield.

Vehicles on Viewfield wishing to access Martyn Street should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Martyn Street wishing to access Victoria Place should proceed north westwards on Martyn Street, north eastwards on Kennedy Drive and south eastwards on Devonview Street to Victoria Place.

Vehicles on Victoria Place wishing to access Martyn Street should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Viewfield wishing to access Victoria Crescent should proceed northwards and eastwards on Viewfield Street, north westwards on Menzies Lane, north eastwards on Kennedy Drive and south eastwards on Devonview Street to Victoria Crescent.

Vehicles on Victoria Crescent wishing to access Viewfield Street should proceed vice versa.

Vehicular access to Rochsolloch Farm Cottages and Knock Drive will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.

Phase 2

Victoria Place, Airdrie from a point 150 metres or thereby, south eastwards of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Saline Street, eastwards for a distance of 80 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Rochsolloch Road, north eastwards on A89 Deedes Street and A89 Alexander Street, south eastwards then eastwards on A89 Weavers Road and south westwards on Broomknoll Street and Victoria Place to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

These works will be phased with no two closures taking place at the same time.

Appropriate signage will be in place advising drivers of the restrictions during each phase of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to adjacent properties will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.

The Order, which will be effective only when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Wednesday, 2 February 2011 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Wednesday, 25 May 2011.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2011

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Victoria Place, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2011” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Wednesday, the second day of February, Two thousand and eleven until 2359 hours on Wednesday, the twenty fifth day of May, Two thousand and eleven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on ground stabilisation works in advance of the installation of a new sewage system) on the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Phase 1

Victoria Place, Airdrie from the extended line of the western kerb of Martyn Street, north eastwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Rochsolloch Farm Cottages.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Victoria Place, north westwards on Rochsolloch Road, north eastwards on A89 Deedes Street and A89 Alexander Street, south eastwards then eastwards on A89 Weavers Road, southwards on Broomknoll Street, and south westwards on Victoria Place to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Martyn Street wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Martyn Street, north westwards and south westwards on Kippen Street, south eastwards on Rochsolloch Road and north eastwards on Victoria Place to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Martyn Street should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Martyn Street wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Martyn Street, north eastwards on Kennedy Drive, south eastwards on Devonview Street and south westwards on Victoria Place to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing wishing to access Martyn Street should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Viewfield wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed northwards then north eastwards on Viewfield, northwards on Menzies Lane, south westwards on Kennedy Drive, south eastwards on Martyn Street, north westwards then south westwards on Kippen Street, south eastwards on Rochsolloch Road and north eastwards on Victoria Place to the south west side of the closure

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Viewfield should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Viewfield wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed north westwards then north eastwards on Viewfield, northwards on Menzies Lane, north eastwards on Kennedy Drive, south eastwards on Devonview Street and south westwards on Victoria Place to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access Viewfield should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Victoria Crescent wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards then north eastwards on Victoria Crescent, north westwards on Devonview Street, north eastwards on Victoria Place, northwards on Broomknoll Street, westwards then north westwards on A89 Weavers Road, south westwards on A89 Alexander Street and A89 Deedes Street, south eastwards on Rochsolloch Road and north eastwards on Victoria Place to the south west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access Victoria Crescent should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Martyn Street wishing to access Viewfield should proceed north westwards on Martyn Street, north eastwards on Kennedy Drive and south eastwards on Menzies Lane to Viewfield.

Vehicles on Viewfield wishing to access Martyn Street should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Martyn Street wishing to access Victoria Place should proceed north westwards on Martyn Street, north eastwards on Kennedy Drive and south eastwards on Devonview Street to Victoria Place.

Vehicles on Victoria Place wishing to access Martyn Street should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Viewfield wishing to access Victoria Crescent should proceed northwards and eastwards on Viewfield Street, north westwards on Menzies Lane, north eastwards on Kennedy Drive and south eastwards on Devonview Street to Victoria Crescent.

Vehicles on Victoria Crescent wishing to access Viewfield Street should proceed vice versa.

Vehicular access to Rochsolloch Farm Cottages and Knock Drive will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.

Phase 2

Victoria Place, Airdrie from a point 150 metres or thereby, south eastwards of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Saline Street, eastwards for a distance of 80 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Rochsolloch Road, north eastwards on A89 Deedes Street and A89 Alexander Street, south eastwards then eastwards on A89 Weavers Road and south westwards on Broomknoll Street and Victoria Place to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

These works will be phased with no two closures taking place at the same time.

Appropriate signage will be in place advising drivers of the restrictions during each phase of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to adjacent properties will be maintained, where possible, by arrangement with the contractor during the closure.
