Mollinsburn Road, Greenfoot by Glenboig

(Temporary Closure) Order 2011

On 16 February 2011 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on level crossing maintenance works) on Mollinsburn Road, Greenfoot by Glenboig from the extended line of the western kerb of Glenboig New Road to the extended line of the southern kerb of Gain Road, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling westwards on Gain Road wishing to access Mollinsburn Road on the south east side of the closure should proceed north westwards, north eastwards and north westwards on Mollinsburn Road, eastwards on Myvot Road, south eastwards on Wester Myvot Road and south eastwards and southwards on B802 Condorrat Road to Mollinsburn Road.

Vehicles travelling north eastwards on Glenboig New Road wishing to access Mollinsburn Road on the north west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Mollinsburn Road, north eastwards and north westwards on Yetts Hole Road and westwards on Gain Road to Mollinsburn Road.

Vehicles travelling south eastwards on Mollinsburn Road at the north west side of the closure wishing to access Mollinsburn Road at the south east side of the closure should proceed eastwards on Gain Road, south eastwards and south westwards on Yetts Hole Road to Mollinsburn Road.

Vehicles travelling north westwards on Mollinsburn Road at the south east side of the closure wishing to access Mollinsburn Road at the north west side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Glenboig New Road, south eastwards on B804 Coatbridge Road, north eastwards on Muirdyke Road, north eastwards then north westwards on Yetts Hole Road, south westwards on Gain Road to Mollinsburn Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, which will be effective only from 2359 hours on Saturdays until 0900 hours on Sundays, will come into operation at 2359 hours on Saturday, 5 March 2011 and will remain in operation until 0900 hours on Sunday, 13 March 2011.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2011

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Mollinsburn Road, Greenfoot by Glenboig) (Temporary Closure) Order 2011" will be effective only during the period from 2359 hours on Saturdays until 0900 hours on Sundays and will come into operation at 2359 hours on Saturday, the fifth day of March, two thousand and eleven until 0900 hours on Sunday, the thirteenth day of March, Two thousand and eleven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on level crossing works) on Mollinsburn Road, Greenfoot by Glenboig from the extended line of the western kerb of Glenboig New Road to the extended line of the southern kerb of Gain Road, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles travelling westwards on Gain Road wishing to access Mollinsburn Road on the south east side of the closure should proceed north westwards, north eastwards and north westwards on Mollinsburn Road, eastwards on Myvot Road, south eastwards on Wester Myvot Road, south eastwards and southwards on B802 Condorrat Road to Mollinsburn Road.

Vehicles travelling north eastwards on Glenboig New Road wishing to access Mollinsburn Road on the north west side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Mollinsburn Road, north eastwards and north westwards on Yetts Hole Road and westwards on Gain Road to Mollinsburn Road.

Vehicles travelling south eastwards on Mollinsburn Road at the north west side of the closure wishing to access Mollinsburn Road at the south east side of the closure should proceed eastwards on Gain Road, south eastwards and south westwards on Yetts Hole Road to Mollinsburn Road.

Vehicles travelling north westwards on Mollinsburn Road at the south east side of the closure wishing to access Mollinsburn Road at the north west side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Glenboig New Road, south eastwards on B804 Coatbridge Road, eastwards on Muirdyke Road, north eastwards on Yetts Hole Road, eastwards on Mollinsburn Road, northwards on B802 Condorrat Road, south westwards on Gain and Shankburn Road and westwards on Gain Road to Mollinsburn Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
