

North Lanarkshire Council
B802 Broomknoll Street, Airdrie
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2011

On 16 March 2011 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the installation of gas and sewer pipes) on Broomknoll Street, Airdrie from the extended line of the northern kerb of Victoria Place to a point 97 metres or thereby north of the extended line of the northern kerb of Victoria Place by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed south eastwards, south westwards then south eastwards on B802 Cairnhill Road, eastwards on B802 Calderbank Road, north eastwards on B8058 Brownsburn Road, northwards on A73 Carlisle Road, westwards on A89 Clark Street and A89 Graham Street, southwards on A89 Gartlea Road and westwards on A89 Weaver Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times where applicable.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 4 April 2011 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 1 July 2011.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (B802 Broomknoll Street, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2011" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the fourth day of April, Two thousand and eleven until 2359 hours on Friday, the first day of July, Two thousand and eleven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the installation of gas and sewer pipes) on Broomknoll Street, Airdrie from the extended line of the northern kerb of Victoria Place to a point 97 metres or thereby north of the extended line of the northern kerb of Victoria Place by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed south eastwards, south westwards then south eastwards on B802 Cairnhill Road, eastwards on B802 Calderbank Road, north eastwards on B8058 Brownsburn Road, northwards on A73 Carlisle Road, westwards on A89 Clark Street and A89 Graham Street, southwards on A89 Gartlea Road and westwards on A89 Weaver Road to the north side of the closure.
