

**North Lanarkshire Council**  
**Various Streets, Balloch, Cumbernauld**  
**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2011**

On 13 June 2011 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on the undernoted roads, by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

**Location 1**

Balloch Road, Balloch from a point three metres south of the extended line of the northern kerb of Redhill Road, south eastwards and south westwards to a point three metres west of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Middlerigg Road, a distance of 265 metres or thereby.

Logan Drive, Balloch from its junction with Balloch Road for a distance of 20 metres or thereby.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed north westwards, south westwards and north westwards on Balloch Road to Craigmarnock Roundabout, south westwards on Eastfield Road to Balloch Roundabout and south eastwards, eastwards, south eastwards and north eastwards on Balloch Road to the south side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed eastwards on Logan Drive, south eastwards then south westwards on Binniehill Road, north westwards on Middlerigg Road, south westwards, north eastwards, south eastwards then north eastwards on Balloch Road to Balloch Roundabout, north eastwards on Eastfield Road to Craigmarnock Roundabout and south eastwards, north eastwards then south eastwards on Balloch Road to the north west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Middlerigg Road, north eastwards then north westwards on Binniehill Road and westwards on Logan Drive to the north east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

**Location 2**

Balloch Road, Balloch from a point three metres east of the extended line of the western kerb of Middlerigg Road, south westwards to a point three metres south of the extended line of the northern kerb of Greenbank Road, a distance of 325 metres or thereby.

Whitehill Avenue, Balloch over its entire length.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards, north westwards, south westwards and north*

*westwards on Balloch Road to Craigmarloch Roundabout, south westwards on Eastfield Road to Balloch Roundabout and south eastwards, eastwards, south eastwards and north eastwards on Balloch Road to the south west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Vehicular access will be provided when practicable.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times

These works will be phased, with no two closures taking place at the same time and will be only operational when signs are in place advising drivers of the restrictions during each phase of the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 27 June 2011 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Wednesday, 8 July 2011.

### Various Streets, Balloch, Cumbernauld

#### (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2011

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restriction) Act 1991), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

- (1) This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, Balloch, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2011" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty seventh day of June, Two Thousand and eleven until 2359 hours on Wednesday, the eighth day of July, Two thousand and eleven.
- (2) No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway resurfacing works) on the undernoted roads, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

#### **Location 1**

Balloch Road, Balloch from a point three metres south of the extended line of the northern kerb of Redhill Road, south eastwards and south westwards to a point three metres west of the extended line of the eastern kerb of Middlerigg Road, a distance of 265 metres or thereby.

Logan Drive, Balloch from its junction with Balloch Road for a distance of 20 metres or thereby.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed north westwards, south westwards and north westwards on Balloch Road to Craigmarloch Roundabout, south westwards on Eastfield Road to Balloch Roundabout and south eastwards, eastwards, south eastwards and north eastwards on Balloch Road to the south side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed eastwards on Logan Drive, south eastwards then south westwards on Binniehill Road, north westwards on Middlerigg Road, south westwards, north eastwards, south eastwards then north eastwards on Balloch Road to Balloch Roundabout, north eastwards on Eastfield Road to Craigmarloch Roundabout and south eastwards, north eastwards then south eastwards on Balloch Road to the north west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

*Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Middlerigg Road, north eastwards then north westwards on Binniehill Road and westwards on Logan Drive to the north east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

#### **Location 2**

Balloch Road, Balloch from a point three metres east of the extended line of the western kerb of Middlerigg Road, south westwards to a point three metres south of the extended line of the northern kerb of Greenbank Road, a distance of 325 metres or thereby.

Whitehill Avenue, Balloch over its entire length.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards, north westwards, south westwards and north westwards on Balloch Road to Craigmarnoch Roundabout, south westwards on Eastfield Road to Balloch Roundabout and south eastwards, eastwards, south eastwards and north eastwards on Balloch Road to the south west side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Vehicular access will be provided when practicable.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times

These works will be phased, with no two closures taking place at the same time and will be only operational when signs are in place advising drivers of the restrictions during each phase of the closure.
