

**North Lanarkshire Council**  
**Kitchener Street, Wishaw**  
**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2011**

On 20 June 2011 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway and footway reconstruction works) on Kitchener Street, Wishaw from its junction with Dryburgh Road to the extended line of the western kerb of French Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Dryburgh Road, south eastwards on Robert Street and north eastwards on French Street to the east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to adjacent properties will be permitted, where practical, during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 11 July 2011 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 23 September 2011.

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2011**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Kitchener Street, Wishaw) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2011” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the eleventh day of July, Two thousand and eleven until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty third day of September, Two thousand and eleven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway and footway reconstruction works) on Kitchener Street, Wishaw from its junction with Dryburgh Road to the extended line of the western kerb of French Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Dryburgh Road, south eastwards on Robert Street and north eastwards on French Street to the east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access to adjacent properties will be permitted, where practical, during the closure.
