

North Lanarkshire Council
Reema Road & Main Street, Bellshill
(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2011

On 20 June 2011 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles being used in connection with the Public Procession on 9 July 2011) on the undernoted roads.

Roads to be closed to all vehicles

Reema Road, Bellshill from the extended line of the western kerb of Bairdsland View, westwards for a distance of 235 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed north westwards then westwards on Reema Road, north westwards then north eastwards on Hattonrigg Road, westwards on Keith Street, south eastwards on North Road, eastwards then south eastwards on Campbell Street and north eastwards on Bairdsland View to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Main Street, Bellshill from the extended line of the western kerb of Emma Jay Road to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Hamilton Road.

Alternative routes: There are no alternative routes.

“No Waiting” Restrictions

To apply to both sides of Reema Road, Bellshill from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Bairdsland View, north eastwards for a distance of 375 metres or thereby.

Appropriate signage will be in place advising drivers of the restrictions during the closure, which will only be valid when appropriate signing is in place.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturday, 9 July 2011 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Saturday, 9 July 2011.

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2011

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Reema Road & Main Street, Bellshill) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2011” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Saturday, the ninth day of July, Two thousand and eleven until 2359 hours on Saturday, the ninth day of July, Two thousand and eleven.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles being used in connection with the Public Procession on 9 July 2011) on the undernoted roads.

Roads to be closed to all vehicles

Reema Road, Bellshill from the extended line of the western kerb of Bairdsland View, westwards for a distance of 235 metres or thereby.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed north westwards then westwards on Reema Road, north westwards then north eastwards on Hattonrigg Road, westwards on Keith Street, south eastwards on North Road, eastwards then south eastwards on Campbell Street and north eastwards on Bairdsland View to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Main Street, Bellshill from the extended line of the western kerb of Emma Jay Road to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Hamilton Road.

Alternative routes: There are no alternative routes.

“No Waiting” Restrictions

To apply to both sides of Reema Road, Bellshill from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Bairdsland View, north eastwards for a distance of 375 metres or thereby.

Appropriate signage will be in place advising drivers of the restrictions during the closure, which will only be valid when appropriate signing is in place.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
