**Un-named Footbridge (Between Corbiston Way and Cumbernauld High School),
Cumbernauld**

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order No 2 2011

On 21 November 2011 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on footbridge refurbishment works) on the un-named footbridge, Cumbernauld from the extended line of the rear boundary fence of 9d Corbiston Way, south eastwards for a distance of 110 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

A temporary footbridge will be provided adjacent to the permanent footbridge.

The Order, which continues the restrictions currently in place by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Monday, 20 June 2011, will come into operation at 2359 hours on Sunday, 4 December 2011 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Tuesday, 31 January 2012.

(Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order No 2 2011

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Un-named Footbridge (Between Corbiston Way and Cumbernauld High School), Cumbernauld) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Movement) Order No 2 2011” and continues the restrictions currently in operation at these locations by virtue of a similar Order made by the Council on Monday, the twentieth day of June, Two thousand and eleven, shall be effective during the period from 2359 hours on Sunday, the fourth day of December, Two thousand and eleven until 2359 hours on Tuesday, the thirty-first day of January, Two thousand and twelve.
2. No person shall proceed on foot (with the exception of pedestrians engaged on footbridge refurbishment works) on the un-named footbridge, Cumbernauld from the extended line of the rear boundary fence of 9d Corbiston Way, south eastwards for a distance of 110 metres or thereby by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

A temporary footbridge will be provided adjacent to the permanent footbridge.
