

North Lanarkshire Council
Brownieside Road, Plains
(Temporary Closure) Order 2012

On 10 January 2012 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage and kerbing works and verge maintenance works) on Brownieside Road, Plains from the extended line of the northern kerb of Stepends Road, north eastwards for a distance of 930 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Stepends Road, westwards on Roughrigg Road, northwards on Craigens Road, north westwards on Towers Road and B8058 Towers Road, north-eastwards on A89 Forrest Street, A89 Airdrie Road and A89 Main Street, southwards and eastwards on the Plains Access Road and southwards on Brownieside Road to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained where practicable during the closure.

Vehicular access will be maintained where practicable during the closure.

The Order, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 23 January 2012 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 10 February 2012.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Brownieside Road, Plains) (Temporary Closure) Order 2012” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-third day of January, two thousand and twelve until 2359 hours on Friday, the tenth day of February, Two thousand and twelve.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on drainage and kerbing works and verge maintenance works) on Brownieside Road, Plains from the extended line of the northern kerb of Stepends Road, north eastwards for a distance of 930 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed south westwards on Stepends Road, westwards on Roughrigg Road, northwards on Craigens Road, north westwards on Towers Road and B8058 Towers Road, north-eastwards on A89 Forrest Street, A89 Airdrie Road and A89 Main Street, southwards and eastwards on the Plains Access Road and southwards on Brownieside Road to the north side of the closure.
