Main Street, Bellshill

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2012

On 23 January 2012 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 to be observed by vehicles on the following roads.

One Way

Main Street, Bellshill from the extended line of the western kerb of Unthank Road, westwards then north westwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Bairdland View in a westwards then north westwards direction.

As a result of the above prohibition of two way traffic on Main Street, Bellshill, the following right and left hand turns are also prohibited:

Prohibition of Right Turn

From Pollock Street, Bellshill onto Main Street, Bellshill

Prohibition of Left Turn

From 449 and 451 Main Street, Bellshill

Alternative routes: Vehicles less than 14' 9" in height on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Campbell Street, south westwards on North Road and Hamilton Road, south eastwards on Crossgates and Motherwell Road, north eastwards then northwards on Calder Road and westwards on Main Street to the south east side of the closure.

Vehicles more than 14' 9" in height on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Campbell Street, south westwards then north westwards on Gartcosh Walk, southwards on A725 to the first exit, southwards on the B7070 southbound off slip road, north eastwards on Bellshill Road and Hamilton Road, south eastwards on Crossgates and Motherwell Road, north eastwards then northwards on Calder Road and westwards on Main Street to the south east side of the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Friday, 10 February 2012 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Thursday, 17 May 2012.

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2012

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The North Lanarkshire Council (Main Street, Bellshill) (Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2012" and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Friday, the tenth day of February, Two thousand and twelve until 2359 hours on Thursday, the seventeenth day of May, Two thousand and twelve.

One Way

Main Street, Bellshill from the extended line of the western kerb of Unthank Road, westwards then north westwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Bairdsland View in a westwards then north westwards direction.

As a result of the above prohibition of two way traffic on Main Street, Bellshill, the following right and left hand turns are also prohibited:

Prohibition of Right Turn

From Pollock Street, Bellshill

Prohibition of Left Turn

From 449 and 451 Main Street, Bellshill

Alternative routes: Vehicles less than 14' 9" in height on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Campbell Street, south westwards on North Road and Hamilton Road, south eastwards on Crossgates and Motherwell Road, north eastwards then northwards on Calder Road and westwards on Main Street to the south east side of the closure.

Vehicles more than 14' 9" in height on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south east side of the closure should proceed north westwards on Campbell Street, south westwards then north westwards on Gartcosh Walk, southwards on A725 to the first exit, southwards on the B7070 southbound off slip road, north eastwards on Bellshill Road and Hamilton Road, south eastwards on Crossgates and Motherwell Road, north eastwards then northwards on Calder Road and westwards on Main Street to the south east side of the closure.
