**A73 Stirling Road, Airdrie**

**(Temporary Speed Limit) Order 2012**

On 6 February 2012 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding the speed limits detailed below (with the exception of emergency service vehicles) on the lengths of the under-noted locations by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

**10 MPH Speed Limit (when convoy system is in operation)**

A73 Stirling Road, Airdrie from a point 100 metres or thereby north west of the extended line of the north western kerb of Dykehead Road, north westwards and northwards to a point 150 metres or thereby south of the extended line of the southern kerb of B803 Raebog Road.

When the convoy is not in operation on the above section of road, the speed limit will be restricted to 30 mph.

Appropriate signing will be in place advising drivers of the speed restrictions in place.

**40 MPH Speed Limit**

A73 Stirling Road, Airdrie from a point 43 metres or thereby south east of the extended line of the south western kerb of Dykehead Road, north westwards for a distance of 100 metres or thereby.

A73 Stirling Road, Airdrie from the extended line of the southern kerb of B803 Raebog Road, southwards for a distance of 150 metres or thereby.

**30 MPH Speed Limit (when signage is in place)**

A73 Stirling Road, Airdrie from a point 43 metres or thereby south east of the extended line of the south western kerb of Dykehead Road, north westwards for a distance of 100 metres or thereby.

A73 Stirling Road, Airdrie from the extended line of the southern kerb of B803 Raebog Road, southwards for a distance of 150 metres or thereby.

The Order, which will be effective only from 0001 hours on Saturdays until 2359 hours on Sundays, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturday, 25 February 2012 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 25 March 2012.

**(Temporary Speed Limit) Order 2012**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (A73 Stirling Road, Airdrie) (Temporary Speed Limit) Order 2012” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Saturdays until 2359 hours on Sundays, from Saturday, the twenty-fifth day of February, two thousand and twelve until Sunday, the twenty-fifth day of March, Two thousand and twelve.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding the speed limits detailed below (with the exception of emergency service vehicles) on the lengths of the under-noted locations by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

**10 MPH Speed Limit (when convoy system is in operation)**

A73 Stirling Road, Airdrie from a point 100 metres or thereby north west of the extended line of the north western kerb of Dykehead Road, north westwards and northwards to a point 150 metres or thereby south of the extended line of the southern kerb of B803 Raebog Road.

When the convoy is not in operation on the above section of road, the speed limit will be restricted to 30 mph.

Appropriate signing will be in place advising drivers of the speed restrictions in place.

**40 MPH Speed Limit**

A73 Stirling Road, Airdrie from a point 43 metres or thereby south east of the extended line of the south western kerb of Dykehead Road, north westwards for a distance of 100 metres or thereby.

A73 Stirling Road, Airdrie from the extended line of the southern kerb of B803 Raebog Road, southwards for a distance of 150 metres or thereby.

**30 MPH Speed Limit (when signage is in place)**

A73 Stirling Road, Airdrie from a point 43 metres or thereby south east of the extended line of the south western kerb of Dykehead Road, north westwards for a distance of 100 metres or thereby.

A73 Stirling Road, Airdrie from the extended line of the southern kerb of B803 Raebog Road, southwards for a distance of 150 metres or thereby.
