**A8011 Link Road and A8011 Glasgow Road, Cumbernauld (Westbound and Eastbound Carriageway)**

**(Temporary Speed Limit) Order 2012**

On 20 February 2012 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the undernoted roads.

A8011 Link Road and A8011 Glasgow Road, Cumbernauld (westbound carriageway) from the junction of the A8011 Link Road and the Back O'Hill roundabout, south eastwards and north eastwards for a distance of 1920 metres or thereby.

A8011 Link Road and A8011 Glasgow Road, Cumbernauld (eastbound carriageway) from the junction of the A8011 Link Road and the Back O'Hill roundabout, south eastwards for a distance of 1100 metres or thereby.

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 12 March 2012 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 22 April 2012.

**(Temporary Speed Limit) Order 2012**

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (A8011 Link Road and A8011 Glasgow Road, Cumbernauld (Westbound and Eastbound Carriageway) (Temporary Speed Limit) Order 2012” and shall be effective only when displayed by signs, during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twelfth day of March, Two thousand and twelve until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twenty second day of April, Two thousand and twelve.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the undernoted roads.

A8011 Link Road and A8011 Glasgow Road, Cumbernauld (westbound carriageway) from the junction of the A8011 Link Road and the Back O’Hill roundabout, south eastwards and north eastwards for a distance of 1920 metres or thereby.

A8011 Link Road and A8011 Glasgow Road, Cumbernauld (eastbound carriageway) from the junction of the A8011 Link Road and the Back O’Hill roundabout, south eastwards for a distance of 1100 metres or thereby.
