

North Lanarkshire Council
Woodside Street, Coatbridge
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012

On 27 February 2012 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main repairs) on Woodside Street, Coatbridge from the extended line of the northern kerb of Allan Street, northwards to its junction with A89 Bank Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on A89 Bank Street, south eastwards on A89 South Circular Road, south westwards on A725 Coatbank Street and A725 Whifflet Street, north westwards on Kirkshaws Road and north eastwards on Woodside Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Saturday, 17 March 2012 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 15 April 2012.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Woodside Street, Coatbridge) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Saturday, the seventeenth day of March, Two thousand and twelve until 2359 hours on Sunday, the fifteenth day of April, Two thousand and twelve.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on gas main repair works) on Woodside Street, Coatbridge from the extended line of the northern kerb of Allan Street, northwards to its junction with A89 Bank Street by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on A89 Bank Street, south eastwards on A89 South Circular Road, south westwards on A725 Coatbank Street and A725 Whifflet Street, north westwards on Kirkshaws Road and north eastwards on Woodside Street to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed vice versa.
