

North Lanarkshire Council
Waverley Drive, Wishaw
(Temporary Closure) Order 2012

On 1 March 2012 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the installation of a traffic calming scheme) on Waverley Drive, Wishaw from its junction with Dryburgh Road, south eastwards and north eastwards to its junction with Coltness Road, a distance of 905 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Dryburgh Road and North Dryburgh Road then south westwards and south eastwards on Coltness Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where practical, by arrangement with the contractor.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 12 March 2012 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 20 April 2012.

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Waverley Drive, Wishaw) (Temporary Closure) Order 2012” and will be operational only when displayed by signs, shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twelfth day of March, two thousand and twelve until 2359 hours on Friday, the twentieth day of April, Two thousand and twelve.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the installation of a traffic calming scheme) on Waverley Drive, Wishaw from its junction with Dryburgh Road, south eastwards and north eastwards to its junction with Coltness Road, a distance of 905 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Dryburgh Road and North Dryburgh Road then south westwards and south eastwards on Coltness Road to the east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the east side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicular access to adjacent premises will be maintained, where practical, by arrangement with the contractor.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
