**Condorrat On-Slip Road to A8011 Glasgow Road (Westbound Carriageway),
Cumbernauld**

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012

On 12 March 2012 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge works in association with the M80 upgrade) on the unnamed on-slip road to the westbound carriageway of the A8011 Glasgow Road from its junction with the Condorrat Ring Road to its junction with the westbound carriageway of the A8011 Glasgow Road, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the west bound carriageway of the A8011 Glasgow Road should continue northwards, westwards and southwards on the unnamed eastbound on-slip road from Condorrat Interchange to A8011 Glasgow Road, proceed north eastwards on A8011 Glasgow Road and north eastwards on the un-named off slip road to Seafar Roundabout, proceed around the roundabout and exit south westwards on the un-named on-slip road to the westbound carriageway of the A8011 Glasgow Road.

Appropriate signage will be in place advising drivers of the restrictions during the closure.

The Order, which will only be effective when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Sunday, 2 April 2012 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 20 April 2012.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Condorrat On-Slip Road to A8011 Glasgow Road (Westbound Carriageway), Cumbernauld) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Sunday, the second day of April, Two thousand and twelve until 2359 hours on Sunday, the twentieth day of April, Two thousand and twelve.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge works in association with the M80 upgrade) on the unnamed on-slip road to the westbound carriageway of the A8011 Glasgow Road from its junction with the Condorrat Ring Road to its junction with the westbound carriageway of the A8011 Glasgow Road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south east side of the closure wishing to access the west bound carriageway of the A8011 Glasgow Road should continue northwards, westwards and southwards on the unnamed eastbound on-slip road from Condorrat Interchange to A8011 Glasgow Road, proceed north eastwards on A8011 Glasgow Road and north eastwards on the un-named off slip road to Seafar Roundabout, proceed around the roundabout and exit south westwards on the un-named on-slip road to the westbound carriageway of the A8011 Glasgow Road.

Appropriate signage will be in place advising drivers of the restrictions during the closure.
