(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012

On 28 May 2012 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer re-lining works) on George Street, Chapelhall from the extended line of the northern kerb of Aitkenhead Road to the extended line of the western kerb of Queen's Crescent by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on George Street, south westwards on B799 Lauchope Street and Woodhall Street, north westwards and westwards on Gibb Street then northwards, north eastwards, south eastwards and south westwards on Queen's Crescent to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicular access will be permitted, where practicable, during the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the duration of the closure.

The Order, which will only be in operation when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0930 hours on Monday, 11 June 2012 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 22 June 2012.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (George Street, Chapelhall) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012” and shall be effective during the period from 0930 hours on Monday, the eleventh day of June, two thousand and twelve until 2359 hours on Friday, the twenty-second day of June, Two thousand and twelve.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on sewer re-lining works) on George Street, Chapelhall from the extended line of the northern kerb of Aitkenhead Road to the extended line of the western kerb of Queen’s Crescent by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on George Street, south westwards on B799 Lauchope Street and Woodhall Street, north westwards and westwards on Gibb Street then northwards, north eastwards, south eastwards and south westwards on Queen’s Crescent to the north side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicular access will be permitted, where practicable, during the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the duration of the closure.
