North Carbrain Road, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Closure) Order 2012

On 28 May 2012 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive, or cause or permit to be driven, any motor vehicle (with the exception of authorised vehicles) on the under-noted roads to allow the London Olympics 2012 Torch Relay to take place on or near those locations.

North Carbrain Road, Cumbernauld from its junction with the Seafar Roundabout, north eastwards to its junction with the Braehead-Muirhead Roundabout

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed around the Seafar Roundabout, exit and proceed north eastwards on the unnamed slip road to A8011 Central Way, north eastwards on A8011 Central Way, north eastwards on the unnamed slip road to the Braehead–Muirhead Roundabout and proceed around the Roundabout to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south west side of the closure should proceed around the Braehead–Muirhead Roundabout, exit and proceed south eastwards on the unnamed slip road to A8011 Central Way, proceed south westwards on A8011 Central Way to the unnamed slip road to Seafar Roundabout, and proceed around the Roundabout to the south east side of the closure.

Stonylee Road, Cumbernauld over its entire length.
Torbrex Road, Cumbernauld over its entire length.
Tarbolton Road, Cumbernauld over its entire length.
Unnamed slip road from northbound B8039 to its junction with North Carbrain Road
Unnamed slip road from northbound B8054 to its junction with North Carbrain Road
Yule Way, Cumbernauld over its entire length.

A local traffic management plan, to be organised and managed by Strathclyde Police, will be in place for residents and local businesses within the closure area.

Vehicular access to the roads will, where possible, be at the discretion of Strathclyde Police.

The Order, which will be effective only when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 0900 hours until 1500 hours on Wednesday, 13 June 2012.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order, which may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (North Carbrain Road, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Closure) Order 2012” and which will be operational only when displayed by signs, shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours until 1500 hours on Wednesday, the thirteenth day of June, Two thousand and twelve.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of authorised vehicles) on the undernoted roads to allow the London Olympics 2012 Torch Relay to take place on or near those locations.
