Bellziehill Roundabout (Northern Bridgedeck), Bellshill

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012

On 6 August 2012 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on waterproofing works) on the northern bridgedeck of Bellziehill Roundabout, Bellshill from the extended line of the eastern kerb of A725 northbound on slip road, eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of A725 southbound off slip road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on A725 northbound on slip road, north eastwards on A725, north eastwards on the northbound off slip road, south eastwards on James Street, south westwards on A725 southbound on slip road, south westwards on A725 and south westwards on the southbound off slip road to the east side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order, which will be operational only when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 2000 hours on Friday, 24 August 2012 and will remain in operation until 0600 hours on Monday, 17 September 2012.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012

The North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Bellziehill Roundabout (Northern Bridgedeck), Bellshill) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2012” and shall be effective during the period from 2000 hours on Friday, the twenty fourth day of August, Two thousand and twelve until 0600 hours on Monday, the seventeenth day of September, Two thousand and twelve.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on waterproofing works) on the northern bridgedeck of Bellziehill Roundabout, Bellshill from the extended line of the eastern kerb of A725 northbound on slip road, eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of A725 southbound off slip road by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative route: Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to access the east side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on A725 northbound on slip road, north eastwards on A725, north eastwards on the northbound off slip road, south eastwards on James Street, south westwards on A725 southbound on slip road, south westwards on A725 and south westwards on the southbound off slip road to the east side of the closure.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
